


INTERACTION

DEVELOP SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

ELECTED OFFICIALS

Need a refresher on how local and state government is structured or a reminder of who your elected officials are? Take the Government 101 for Citizens of Michigan Course on moveitchristian.com with exercises that help you identify your elected officials.

CONNECT

- Attend local government meetings to observe and interact with school board members, city or township board members, and county commissioners.
- Review your municipal and county government websites to see what they are promoting (or suppressing).
- Monitor the state and federal legislative sites to watch for bills that are under consideration and must be either supported or opposed. Lobby state or federal legislators via phone or email. Encourage your neighbors to do the same.
- Find (or develop) a local news source that will give an accurate account of the actions taken by elected officials, including those less easily engaged, such as local judges and county executives.

ELECTED OFFICIALS

MHA CONNECTS

Each one of your elected officials has a level of influence and decision-making power to affect your life and the life of others in your community – either for good or bad.

Every Christian and constitutionalist should be actively watching and influencing the elected officials who mold, enact and enforce our policies at every level. If they do good, commend them - but if they violate their oath to the Constitution or vote for policies that harm their constituents, citizens are obligated to warn their neighbors and replace them.

VOTERS

CONNECT

- Attend community events! Engage your neighbors at parades, pancake breakfasts, neighborhood cookoffs and fall/spring cleanups. Not a lot going on in your neighborhood? Be the one that organizes the event.
- Always watch for opportunities to help someone in need. Help with groceries or yard clean up...have a coffee with someone that is lonely...

MHAS

Establish trust and add value to your neighbors' lives. Be a positive influence to promote worthy causes, as well as increase voter awareness. Use your "banked trust" to increase turnout for constitutional candidates!

POLITICAL PARTIES

CONNECT

- Attend local political party meetings and events to observe and interact with party officers and executive committee members.
- Review the county, district and state party websites
 to see what they are promoting (or suppressing) –
 election integrity, sanctity of every human life,
 traditional marriage, etc.

In their national party platforms, the major political parties claim to defend constitutional rights.

Despite this, many (most?) politicians no longer use the U.S. Constitution and the moral absolutes defined in the Ten Commandments as the measure for internal party accountability, electability and governing.

If your county or state party boldly preserves, protects and defends the U.S. Constitution and the God-given inalienable rights of every American citizen, they need you to support them with your time and treasure!

CANDIDATES FOR ELECTED OFFICE

CONNECT

- Attend campaign events during primary election campaign season to meet the candidates and ask the tough questions.
- Review their website and social media to see who and what they are promoting (or suppressing).

CONSTITUTIONAL & FAITH-BASED GROUPS

CONNECT

- Attend events hosted by local constitutional and faith-based groups to meet the group leaders and understand their mission, values and goals. This may include the local pregnancy resource center, homeless ministries, foster care agencies, constitutional political action committees, election integrity groups and more...
- Review their website and social media to see who and what they are promoting (or suppressing).
