What is a local biblical citizenship team and why is it so important?

A local biblical citizenship team is pastors, elders and church leaders within each county collaborating with one another and other local biblical citizen leaders to:

- De-fracture the body of Christ, working together to influence local community and government according to Scriptural and Constitutional principles
- Train Christians in the fundamentals of biblical citizenship, realizing that each blessing (freedom or inalienable right) comes with a corresponding responsibility
- Provide Christians with opportunities to use their God-given time and talents effectively and efficiently to bring God glory within local community and government, either as gatekeepers or critical assistants

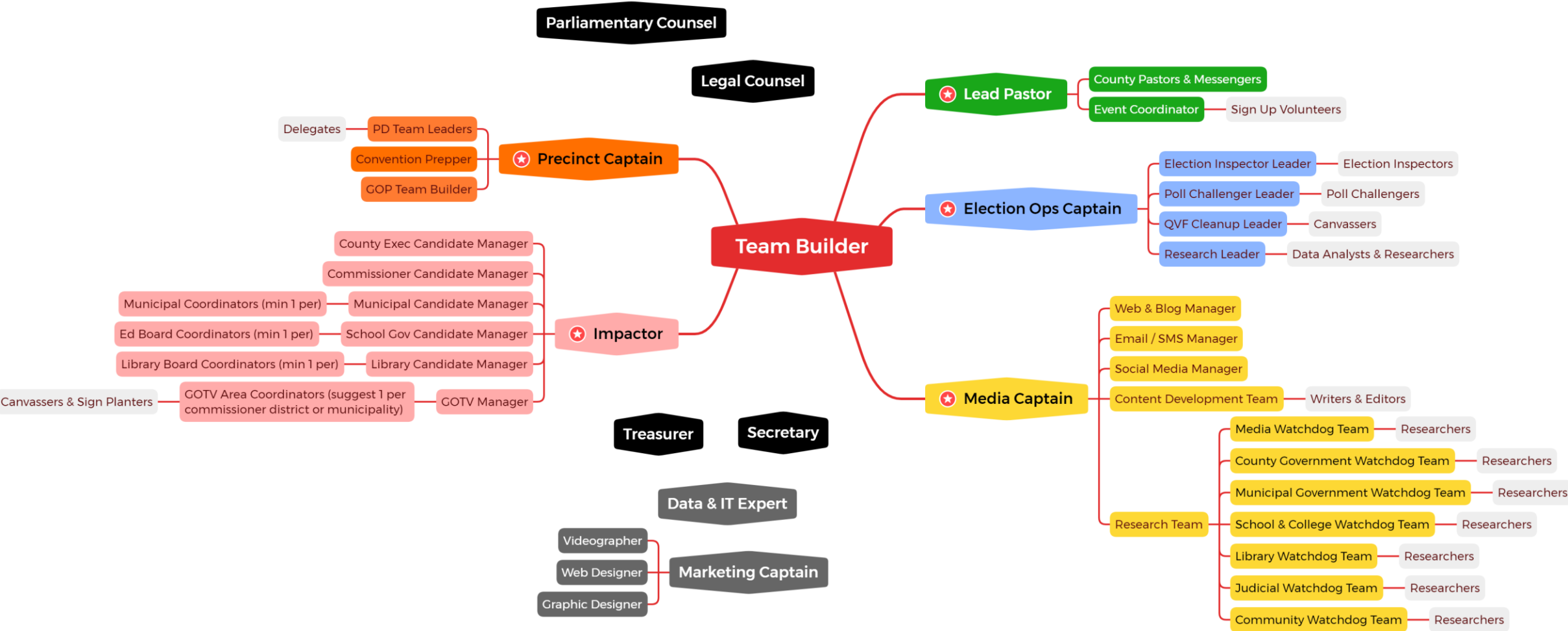
PRIMARY FOCUS MISSIONS

RESTORE THE ROLE OF CHURCH IN STATE

Wake up the church.

The foremost mission is to reawaken pastors and the body of Christ to their responsibility as biblical citizens to influence local community and government according to Scriptural and Constitutional principles for God's glory!

Without success on this front, we cannot expect freedom and blessings elsewhere.

PASTORAL TEAM

Lead Pastor & Church Leaders

Leadership of the pastoral team requires a pastor with excellent networking and team management capabilities to bring pastors and other church leaders in the county together and keep them well-informed of news and events affecting the local community, so they can respond appropriately and share announcements, resources and service opportunities with the Christians in their respective churches.

Event Coordinator & Sign-Up Volunteers

The pastoral team will host biblical citizenship training courses and presentations from other biblical citizen leaders and community gatekeepers. The event coordinator will work with the pastoral team to procure resources, maximize turnout, and line up volunteers to man the event and provide direction for Christians who want to plug in.

RESTORE TRUTH IN MEDIA

As the media goes, so goes the nation.

We are engaged in information warfare, a battle to find the truth, to separate fact from manufactured narrative.

The mission to restore truth in media involves the collaborative effort of biblical citizens to regularly investigate local government bodies, non-profits, businesses, schools, etc. and share their findings with the rest of the local community through the employment of various forms of media.

COMMUNICATIONS TEAM

Media Captain

Leadership of the communications team requires a servant leader with excellent networking and team management capabilities to bring researchers, content developers and media managers together, so they can keep the community well-informed of news, announcements, and events affecting the local community.

Research Team

The research team has managers and community watchdogs each focused on a particular aspect of the community – various local government bodies, media outlets, businesses, medical centers, non-profit organizations, etc.

COMMUNICATIONS TEAM

Content Development Team

The content development team is writers and editors who receive information and source data from the research team that they use to craft messaging for various forms of media.

Managers for Websites, Blogs, Mass Email or Text, Social Media, etc.

Each form of media is overseen by a manager who pushes out the messaging crafted by the content development team.

RESTORE ELECTION INTEGRITY

Systemic election corruption threatens our national survival.

Our freedom in America relies heavily on our sacred right to vote. Without election integrity, we are no longer able to elect representatives who represent the best interests of We the People – rather, we are left with tyrants who represent their own agenda.

The mission to restore election integrity requires the involvement of biblical citizens to fill the roles of election inspector, poll challenger, canvasser, researcher and data analyst.

ELECTION INTEGRITY TEAM

Election Ops Captain

Leadership of the election integrity team requires a servant leader with excellent networking and team management capabilities to bring the human resources together for the goal of restoring and maintaining secure election systems for the local community.

Election Inspector Team

A team leader recruits biblical citizens to become election inspectors and provides direction on who to contact for training.

Poll Challenger Team

A team leader recruits biblical citizens to become poll challengers, offers challenger training sessions and provides direction on how to be credentialed.

ELECTION INTEGRITY TEAM

QVF Cleanup Team

A team leader organizes biblical citizens to canvass the local community and work with a non-partisan statewide organization, Check My Vote, to audit addresses and clean up the Qualified Voter File, which has hundreds of thousands of illegal voter registrations on record.

Research Team

A team leader organizes biblical citizens to research and analyze information that impacts the battle for election integrity. Some team members will analyze election results to identify anomalies and evidence of fraud. Others will research the ruling history of district, circuit and appellate court judges to identify legal paths for prosecuting fraud and restoring election integrity. Still others may develop processes and procedures for counting ballots manually at the precinct level.

RESTORE THE “PARTY OF THE CONSTITUTION”

The Republican Party promotes itself as the “Party of the Constitution” and played a large role in ending slavery in America under the leadership of Abraham Lincoln.

When managed properly, the Republican Party is a powerful messaging platform for defending the biblical principles contained in our nation’s founding documents and holding elected leaders accountable.

The Republican Party has been infiltrated by bad actors who have brought this powerful messaging platform into a state of engineered inefficiency as part of their agenda to destroy America.

The mission to restore the “party of the constitution” requires the involvement of biblical citizens to fill the role of precinct delegate and work collaboratively to elect servant leadership for the county party executive committee and beyond.

PRECINCT STRATEGY TEAM

Precinct Captain

Leadership of the precinct strategy team requires a servant leader with excellent networking and team management capabilities to develop and train precinct delegate teams.

Precinct Delegate Teams

Multiple team leaders recruit and communicate regularly with groups of precinct delegates throughout the county, keeping them well-informed of news and events involving the party, so they can take appropriate action on behalf of the citizens in their respective precincts.

PRECINCT STRATEGY TEAM

Party Team Builder

It is no small task to bring together the right individuals with varying talents and backgrounds to lead a county party and properly fulfil all the party purposes. The party team builder will work with the precinct delegate team leaders to put together a solid team to fight for scriptural and constitutional principles.

Convention Prepper

An individual with county convention experience and a solid understanding of parliamentary procedure will work with the precinct delegate team leaders to prepare biblical citizen delegates to win at convention.

RESTORE LOCAL CONSTITUTIONAL GOVERNING

Fill every county and municipal government seat with Christians and constitutionalists.

A team of biblical citizens may not have much impact on national or even statewide elections, but they can drastically alter local government bodies. Christians and constitutionalists must fill the “lesser magistrate” roles to protect the citizens of the community from tyrants and refuse to enforce laws that violate God-given inalienable rights.

GOVERNMENT IMPACT TEAM

Lead Impactor

Leadership of the government impact team requires a servant leader with excellent networking and team management capabilities to build and facilitate sub-teams for impacting each local government body – county, municipal, school, library, etc.

Candidate Managers & Coordinators

Multiple managers and coordinators recruit and communicate regularly with candidates for local government, syncing campaign messaging and activities to maximize impact.

Get Out the Vote Team

A servant leader organizes geographical teams to combine get out the vote efforts for all constitutional candidates on the ballot within each precinct – planting yard signs, canvassing neighborhoods and distributing literature.

TEAM FACILITATOR

One dedicated individual brings together the leaders responsible for each primary focus mission – the lead pastor, the media captain, the election operations captain, the precinct captain and the lead impactor – to form the leadership board for the biblical citizenship team.

The team facilitator maintains regular communication and collaboration between biblical citizen leaders to efficiently and effectively restore Scriptural and Constitutional principles in all sectors of the local community for God's glory!

OTHER EXPERTISE NEEDED

Secretary

The secretary keeps accurate record of biblical citizenship team meetings and maintains custody of team documents.

Data & Information Technology

The biblical citizenship team in a small county may use a few **spreadsheets** to keep track of voters, volunteers and other data, while a larger team may require **team management software**, complex **data management software**, and customized **mobile “get-out-the-vote” applications**.

The “data team” may range from one individual doing data entry and running spreadsheets (small county) to a team of data entry volunteers, digital security and technology experts (large county).

OTHER EXPERTISE NEEDED

Marketing

A small biblical citizenship team will need at least one graphic designer to make a few mailer designs, while a larger team may require several web designers, graphic designers and videographers!

Legal & Parliamentary Counsel

Each biblical citizenship team should have one or more constitutional lawyers and credentialed parliamentarians to contact for both legal and parliamentary advice.



The success of the biblical citizenship team is dependent on Christians willing to sacrifice time and treasure.

Onboard and train volunteers properly.

Biblical citizen volunteers are awesome. Provide them with **clear, specific directions** on how they can add value.

Do not leave your critical assistants feeling as though they are wasting their time! Things can quickly move from bad to worse and destroy the team from within.

- Identify specific tasks that need to be done.
- Decide who will report to who – and how! Create an **organizational chart** for the team (or use the one shown earlier) to establish the chain of command and facilitate proper feedback loops.
- Team leaders must *communicate often* with volunteers and provide steady direction.



Show critical assistants how much their support is appreciated.

- Be intentional and meaningful when expressing gratitude.
- Set aside time to send personal hand-written thank you cards or make thank you calls.
- Recognize that some team members may appreciate gifts or public recognition!

FORM A POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE

A Biblical Citizenship Team can achieve large accomplishments as an unofficial loose network of citizens coming together for a common purpose, but they are restricted from engaging in several important political activities.

A team can only endorse or spend funds on behalf of candidates or ballot questions (voter guides, candidate fundraisers, etc.) when they become an official organization. To do so, the team must form a political action committee (PAC) following the six steps detailed in the next slides.

1

REQUEST AN EIN

Obtain an Employer Identification Number (EIN) from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). Fill out the online application for an EIN at [IRS.gov](https://www.irs.gov).

Helpful tips when completing the application:

- Type of Legal Structure: *Additional Types / Tax-Exempt & Governmental Organizations / Political Organization*
- Reason for Requesting EIN: *Started a new business*
- Responsible Party: *Individual (officer or board member of PAC)*
- Start Date: *month applying for EIN*
- Form 8871 under Sec 527 filer: *YES*
- Employees: *likely "NO"*
- Receive letter online: *YES*

FIND A TREASURER

The Treasurer for the Biblical Citizenship PAC should have accounting experience and must understand the requirements of Michigan Campaign Finance Law.

Campaign finance reports must be filed accurately and on time with either the county clerk (county PAC) or the Michigan Bureau of Elections (state PAC).

FILE ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

File Articles of Organization with the county clerk or the MI Bureau of Elections. Find the Statement of Organization form for Political Action Committees at [Michigan.gov/sos/elections](https://michigan.gov/sos/elections).

Helpful tips when completing the application:

- Type of Filing: *Original*
- Committee Type: *Independent Expenditure Committee*
- Where to File: If the districts of all the candidates supported or opposed by the PAC are located wholly within the same county, the committee files the Statement of Organization with the clerk of that county. If the districts of any of the candidates supported or opposed are not located wholly within the same county, the committee files electronically with the Michigan Bureau of Elections.

OPEN A BANK ACCOUNT

Use the Employer Identification Number to open a bank account at the depository specified on the Statement of Organization for the PAC.

FORM A BUDGET COMMITTEE

Each PAC should have a Budget Committee analyzing the funds raised, assessing the PAC's financial needs and establishing a budget to cover operations and candidate support.

SET UP INTERNAL SYSTEMS

- Develop a **Mission Statement**.
- Create a **Logo**.
- Purchase a **Domain Name** (DNS) from a DNS provider.
- Find a **Web Host** for your site.
- Obtain the services of a web designer to create the **Website**.
- Select and customize **Team Management Software** for internal team communications and documents.
- Set up **Social Media Accounts** to reach the biblical citizen of your local community on various platforms.
- Select and customize a system for sending **Mass Email and/or SMS** to subscribers and volunteers.
