IMPACT STRATEGY

Fill every county and municipal government seat with Christians and constitutionalists.

John Adams said, *“Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.”*

James Madison wrote that our Constitution requires *“sufficient virtue among men for self-government,”* otherwise, *“nothing less than the chains of despotism can restrain them from destroying and devouring one another.”*

IMPACT the COUNTY

Elect Christians and constitutionalists for each county executive seat and a majority of county commissioner seats.

County Executives

- Clerk
- Sheriff
- Prosecuting Attorney
- Treasurer
- Water and Sewer (or Drain) Commissioner
- Road Commissioner(s)

County Commissioner Board

Each Michigan county has an odd number of county commissioners. As of 2022, the smallest county commission has 5 members, and the largest has 21 members.

WIN between 9 and 17 county government offices to restore constitutional governance in your county!

IMPACT the MUNICIPALITY

Elect Christians and constitutionalists for each municipal executive seat and a majority of municipal board seats.

Municipal Executives

- Supervisor (Township) or Mayor (City)
- Clerk
- Treasurer

Municipal Board

Each municipality has a government board. In cities, it's a commissioner board: in townships, it's a board of trustees.

IMPACT the SCHOOLS

Elect Christians and constitutionalists for a majority of school board seats.

There are over 500 public school districts in Michigan, almost 3,000 schools, and over 1.25 million students.
